





Hygiene education program deployed at all AquaTower project schools.

Myanmar



Emergency response to provide safe drinking water to people impacted by the earthquake in Myanmar.

Following the devastating 7.7 magnitude earthquake that hit Myanmar in late March 2025, the Planet Water Foundation Disaster Response team mobilized to provide support.

With aftershocks still ongoing, five AquaTower systems were successfully installed in evacuation camps in Sagaing, Mandalay, and Naypyitaw to provide safe water access to community members who had been displaced by the disaster.

Emergency response to provide safe drinking water to people impacted by Hurricane Melissa in Jamaica.

In the wake of Hurricane Melissa's devastation, the Planet Water Foundation Disaster Response Team provided rapid support to communities which had been devastated.

High-capacity AquaBlock emergency water filtration system were deployed in some of the hardest-hit communities - supporting up to 36,000 people on their long road to recovery.




